First, locate and record citations to books, periodicals, and documents that may contain useful information and ideas on your topic. Briefly examine and review the actual items.

An annotated bibliography and a sound index end the volume. Broader in scope than either Jenean Romberg's Let's Discover Puppets (Center for Applied Research in Education, 1976) or Jeffrey L. Peyton's Puppetools: Introductory Guide and Your Specialized Applications Manual (Prescott Durell, 1986), this is an excellent resource for school or public libraries with a focus on puppets as literary and promotional tools.

An Annotated Bibliography can include any type of resource unless otherwise specified by the assignment. This can include (but is not limited to): Scholarly materials; Interviews; Government documents; Websites; Books; Media; Annotated Bibliographies can be a great resource for students before they write other types of assignments, like literature reviews.

## **Pfeiffer Library: Creating an Annotated Bibliography in ...**

An annotated bibliography is a list of sources (books, articles, websites, etc.) with short paragraph about each source. An annotated bibliography is sometimes a useful step before drafting a research paper, or it can stand alone as an overview of the research available on a topic. Each source in the annotated bibliography has a citation - the information a reader needs to find the original source, in a consistent format to make that easier.

Sometimes the annotation will reflect the applicability of the source to the needs of the researcher. The purpose of this type of bibliography is to inform the reader of the relevance, accuracy, and quality of the sources cited.
