Uniform Bar Examination - NCBE

Multistate Bar Exam (MBE) Scores Score Transfers: The Idaho State Bar will accept transferred MBE scores earned in another jurisdiction or from a previous unsuccessful attempt at the Idaho Bar Exam. The MBE must have been taken within 37 months prior to the date of the Idaho bar examination for which an applicant is applying.

The Bar Exam and MBE

You must meet the following minimum requirements to apply under Rule 7B: Submit your application within 24 months of the date of the qualifying examination being used as the basis for admission Have an MBE scaled score of 145 or higher on the qualifying examination Be admitted in the state or jurisdiction where you took the exam

Generally, a bar exam tests applicants for admission on a pre-selected comprehensive array of legal subjects identified as essential to entering legal practice in a jurisdiction. The core components of any bar exam are the Multistate Bar Exam (MBE), the Multistate Essay Exam (MEE) or state essays, and the Multistate Performance Test (MPT).

Multistate Bar Examination - NCBE

The Bar Exam & MBE OVERVIEW The Bar Exam is an examination administered in each state to assess whether or not a candidate is competent to practice law in that jurisdiction. The format for each state's bar exam is different, but usually is broken into two parts that are taken on two separate days.

The Bar Exam & MBE

No state-specific law is tested on the MBE. The subjects you will encounter on the MBE are as follows: Civil Procedure, Constitutional Law, Contracts, Criminal Law and Procedure, Evidence, Real Property, and Torts. For many Bar takers, the MBE comprises as much as 50% of their total Bar exam score, so its importance cannot be understated.

Purpose. accept MBE scores earned in a previous examination or concurrently in another jurisdiction for purposes of making local admission decisions if they wish. Note: candidates must sit for all portions of the UBE in the same UBE jurisdiction and in the same administration in order to earn a portable UBE score;

To pass the bar exam, you must receive a passing score on the MBE. In those jurisdictions that have adopted the UBE, the MBE is worth 50% of the exam; making it nearly impossible to pass the bar...

Taking The Mbe Bar Exam

Most commonly, some state bar examiners will accept the Multistate Bar Exam (MBE) scores from a concurrent exam. Practically speaking, this means that applicants will sit for three (very likely consecutive) days of exams: one day for the MBE, and one day for each of the two states.

The MBE is a component of the Uniform Bar Examination (UBE). Jurisdictions that administer the UBE weight the MBE component 50%. Purpose. The purpose of the MBE is to assess the extent to which an examinee can apply fundamental legal principles and legal reasoning to analyze given fact patterns.
